MINUTES OF THE JUNE 7, 2022 ANNUAL MEETING

The Annual Meeting of the North Tiverton Fire District was held via Zoom platform and called to order by the Moderator, Mrs. Sally Ferreira at 7:00. The quorum was met and the Administrative Board members in attendance were Mrs. Sally Ferreira, Mr. Bruce Barcelou, Mr. Carl Dumas, Mr. Jay Jackson, Mr. Richard Tierney, Mr. Joseph Emanuel and Mr. Jeffrey LaChapelle. Also in attendance were, Mr. Paul L'Heureux (General Manager) and Mr. Robert Ouellette (Superintendent).

The Warrant for the Annual Meeting was read by Jeffrey LaChapelle followed by the election of officers: Mr. Richard Tierney, Tax Collector. Mr. John Jackson, Treasurer. Mrs. Sally Ferreira made a motion to elect the slate of nominees as a block and it was seconded by Mrs. Carl Dumas. The motion was voted on by all in attendance and was approved to approve the election of officers which was unanimous.

Treasurer's Report: Mr. Jackson read the Annual Report for the District explaining its financial stability. Mr. Dumas made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report as read and Mr. Barcelou seconded, and it passed unanimously.

Tax Collector's Report: Mr. Richard Tierney read the Tax Collector's Report. The report stated the progress of collecting back taxes in the district. Mr. Jackson made a motion to accept the Tax Collector's report as read and Mr. Emanuel seconded, and it was passed unanimously.

Mr. L'Heureux stated to the members of the district in attendance that the tax rate will not change from its current rate of .94 cents per thousand. Mr. Tierney made a motion to accept the new tax rate that was seconded by Mr. Jackson. The motion was voted on by all in attendance and it was unanimous.

At this time, the meeting was opened to the public to ask any questions. There were no questions from the public.

Adjournment: With no further business to be conducted, a motion to adjourn at 7:15 was made by Mr. Dumas and seconded by Mr. Emanuel which was passed unanimously by the Board.
